A shogi opening (openingsenpō) is the sequence of initial moves of a shogi game before the middle game. The more general Japanese term for the beginning of the game is openingsenpō joban.. A Jōseki (openingjoseki) is the especially recommended sequence of moves for a given opening that was considered balanced play at one point in time for both sides by professional players.
