Respiratory alkalosis is a disturbance in acid and base balance due to alveolar hyperventilation. Alveolar hyperventilation leads to a decreased partial pressure of arterial carbon dioxide (PaCO 2).In turn, the decrease in PaCO 2 increases the ratio of bicarbonate concentration to PaCO 2 and, thereby, increases the pH level; thus the descriptive term respiratory alkalosis.
