Problem and solution is very closely related to cause and effect, but the big difference is the solution. This is something I'll write on the slide and I'll expect the kids to write it in their notes. When I get to the slide with the problem and solution paragraph, I'll ask students to read it and find the problem and solution.

How to Identify the Problem and Solution in a Reading ...

The problem and solution text structure may seem like it would be easy to recognize, but it can be moderately difficult to identify because it is frequently confused with the cause and effect pattern of organization, as they both have relational structures; however, if you read the passage and look specifically for both a problem and a solution to the problem, you should find it pretty easy to ...

Problem and Solution | Ereading Worksheets

Tell the class that they'll be looking for problems and solutions in fiction text. Explain that a problem is something the character wants to figure out, change, or fix. A solution is the way a problem is solved or fixed.; Give each student two sticky notes and display the chart papers labeled with Problem and Solution. Model writing the problem and solution from the Introduction on two sticky ...

What's Your Problem? Teaching Problem and Solution

Then, in whatever discipline you teach, present your students with thorny, real-world problems that have no clear-cut solution and get them to use the problem-solving process to come up with solutions. Resist the urge to solve the problem for them. Resist the temptation of having one solution in mind.

How to Teach Problem Solving | Thoughtful Learning K-12

Use mentor text picture books to teach problem and solution text structure which improves reading and writing skills including making informed predictions. Show children what to expect in a problem-solution story as well as how authors structure a problem-solution story or essay.

Picture Books to Teach Problem and Solution | Imagination Soup

Teach/Active Engagement (10-12 mins): Sometimes authors choose to organize a text using the problem and the solution. A problem is an obstacle or an event that causes a person to be worried or unhappy.

Mentor Texts for Informational Text Structures - The ...

Many teachers and publications recommend the teaching of sequence and description text structures prior to teaching other text structures. As noted earlier, problem and solution is rarely taught and some text structure interventions suggest that cause and effect and problem and solution are similar and therefore can be reduced to just cause and effect.

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
